<b>Prerequisite(s) if any</b>	
<b>Objectives of the Course</b>	The objective of the Civil Law course, which is the most basic course in the field of private law, is to prepare the student for deepening in the field of private law by providing students with the basic concepts of private law, the initial provisions of the Turkish Civil Code, Law of Persons and Family Law.
<b>Short Course Content</b>	The content of this course consists of the provisions between Articles 1 and 494 of the Turkish Civil Code (No. 4721). In this context, first-year students are first taught the definition and nature of law, the concept of right and basic legal principles, which are an introduction to private law. In the light of these basic principles, the concepts of birth, acquisition, protection and limits of right, discrimination of rights, sources of law, implementation of laws, interpretation of laws, the concept of void, the rule of honesty, presumption of good faith, and discretion are taught. Afterwards, the beginning of personality, rights and deeds, real persons and legal entities in the context of law of persons are explained. Ultimately, in the subject of family law, the concept of family, the establishment of a marriage union, the legal status, rights and obligations that occur with the establishment of marriage, the termination of marriage, the consequences of the termination and property regimes between spouses are taught
