In this context, acquisition and loss of Turkish citizenship within the framework of Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901; Status and rights of foreigners in Turkey within the scope of the Constitution and relevant legislation; The law applicable to private law relations with foreign elements within the scope of the Law on International Private Law and Procedural Law No. 5718; International jurisdiction of Turkish courts, international procedural law, recognition and enforcement of foreign court decisions and international arbitration.
