Objectives of the Course	Notification law is bound to strict form rules to inform persons about information about the transactions regarding them. In this respect, the main purpose of the course for fourth grade students is informing them about notification types, stages of notification, irregular notification and similar institutions and to provide them with the skills to use this theoretical knowledge in practice.
Short Course Content	In notification law courses, general information on notification law, application area of notification law, persons to be notified, notification place and notification time, notification to legal persons, notification to persons residing in the same residence on behalf of the addressee, notification in case of addressee temporarily going elsewhere, impossibility of notification -avoiding the notification, notification report, notification abroad, notification by publication, irregular notification, notification in case of change of address and penal provisions regarding notification are covered.
